

Atelier Franco-Allemand “Autour du Rituel” 28.4.2003

The first french-german Atelier was organized by the subproject (B5) “Court ritual in the Jaipur state” (Monika Boehm-Tettelbach, Jörg Gengnagel) of the Sonderforschungsbereich “Ritual Dynamics”. One of the aims of the meeting was to coordinate french and german research projects on rituals in South Asia. The french research team “Rites hindous: transferts et transformations” (CNRS, Paris) was represented by Dr. Gérard Colas (EHESS-CNRS, Paris).
